GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION
MARCH 20, 2018

Voting for the March 20, 2018 General Primary Election is now being conducted in the office of the County Clerk, first floor, Richland County Courthouse. Various ways to vote prior to the election are:

EARLY VOTING— If you desire to vote early for any or no reason you may vote in person at the county clerk's office. This temporary polling place is open during regular office hours, Monday – Friday, 8 AM to 4 PM. No appointment is necessary. **EARLY VOTING ENDS MARCH 19, 2018.**

GRACE PERIOD VOTING – This is for a qualified voter who failed to register or change their address previous to close of registration. A voter may go to the county clerk's office, register to vote, and **AT THAT TIME** vote.

VOTE BY MAIL- If you prefer to Vote by Mail please call the County Clerk's Office. 618-392-3111. We will mail out an application, you return it, then we mail the ballot. The ballot can be returned by mail or carried back to the office. Please call as soon as possible to do this, as time is a factor.
